This contract must be submitted to the Guidance Office by **June 6, 2006**. One copy will be submitted to the AP teacher, one to the student's counselor, and one to the student. **If the contract is not returned, the student will be removed from the class before the start of the year.**

- ____ 1. Students enrolled in Advanced Placement classes at Carson High School may be required to complete a summer assignment. Students who do not have the assignments completed on the first day of school will receive a zero for these assignments with no option for late submissions or for dropping the class.
- ____ 2. Students who wish to drop the class must do so by June 6, 2006. Students will not be dropped after this date.
- ____ 3. Students enrolled in Advanced Placement courses at Carson High School are required to take the Advanced Placement test that is given in May. Each test costs approximately \$85. This fee must be paid prior to November 1st of each year. If the fee is not paid, students will have Advanced Placement (AP) removed from their transcript.
