OLD NEWS & SCHOLARSHIP

1. KIWANIS CLUB VIRGINIA NUZUM/JIM ALBEE TRADE SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION - This scholarship is for seniors who plan to pursue training for a career in a trade such as construction, automotive, welding, cosmetology, culinary arts, massage therapy, dental hygienist, health aid, or EMT. Applications are available at <http://www.carsonhigh.com/new/main/guidance.html>. Click on "College Scholarship Applications" on the left, and you will find the application in that list. Applications must be received by the sponsor by 6/1/20.
2. **BOURQUE SCHOLARSHIP** - Seniors who are pursuing a post-secondary degree in music, currently participating in choir or musical theatre should apply for this scholarship. One \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting the above qualifications and who is getting his/her Fine Arts Diploma from CHS. **Due 5/29/20**. Email to achambers@carson.k12.nv.us. 4. TEXTBOOK BROKERS SCHOLARSHIP: Answering eight questions earns your chance at a full textbook scholarship for Fall 2020! One in 50 applicants will win. In order to be eligible, you must be of freshman standing and planning to enroll with the University of Nevada, Reno, Truckee Meadows Community College, or College of Southern Nevada. Apply at <https://www.booknv.com/>. Click on the “Scholarships” tab.
5. FAFSA - The FAFSA is available online now. Students can begin to register for their pin numbers at www.pin.ed.gov. Forms of aid include grants, loans, and college work study. All SENIORS SHOULD APPLY online at www.fafsa.ed.gov, or download the myStudentAid mobile app.. Download the myStudentAid app in the [Apple App Store](#) (iOS) or [Google Play](#) (Android). The myFAFSA component—which is used to complete the FAFSA form—is the app’s featured function. Note: If you downloaded the app prior to Oct. 1, you must download an update to access the 2019–2020 FAFSA form.
6. ANGELS WINGS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS: Available to Thai students residing in Nevada. \$5000 scholarships will be awarded to students attending community college, and \$10,000 scholarships will be awarded to students attending 4-year universities. Applicants will be evaluated on academic promise, high school performance, and essay response. Apply at www.angelswingsfoundation.org. Due 5/18/20.

8. DIGITAL RESPONSIBILITY SCHOLARSHIPS- Several scholarships are open for students interested in writing essays on the topics of digital responsibility, technology dependency, and digital privacy. 10. ARMY OFFICER ROTC SCHOLARSHIP - Full tuition scholarships are available or \$4000 per semester. This scholarship is for anyone who wants to be an officer for the Army, Army National Guard, or Army Reserves. The scholarship can be used at any Army ROTC program across the nation as long as you are accepted into that university. To be competitive for the scholarship, the following is recommended: 1200 SAT or 27 ACT; club, sports and other organization participation; 3.6 unweighted GPA.
