Getting Started Checklist

- Gather everything you need to succeed in class.

- □ Sign in, reset your password, and set up security questions.
- □ Launch the course window by selecting a course title from the My Dashboard screen.
- □ Online Help is available 24/7 by signing in to Apex Learning and selecting Help.

Your school will provide your username, password, and the correct URL – most students sign in at <u>www.apexvs.com</u>. For security reasons, Apex Learning Support does not distribute sign in information.

How to Submit Your Work


