## STUDENT DRESS CODE

Purpose of the dress code: is to promote a learning environment that is respectful and free from distractions. Clothing must be **MODEST** and must not promote or glorify illegal, promiscuous, gang-related or racially-biased slogans or behaviors. In order to create a learning atmosphere that is respectful and free from distractions, the following must be adhered to:

- Any attire associated with gangs, tobacco, drugs, alcohol, violence or discrimination will not be acceptable on campus.
- Undergarments (bras, underwear, boxer shorts, etc.) should not be visible. Sheer and see through clothing is not allowed.
- Pajamas and slippers are not allowed.
- Blouses and shirts should not show cleavage and skin should not be visible at midriff.
- Halter-tops, backless shirts, sleeveless shirts and strapless garments are not allowed. Shirts must have sleeves and cover the shoulders.
- Hats, caps, hoods, bandanas, scarves, and other head coverings may not be worn inside school buildings. This includes bandanas worn as headbands.
- Sunglasses and gloves may not be worn in school buildings
- Shorts, skirts and dresses must extend below the fingertips with arms in a relaxed position.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- No face painting concealing identity in any form is allowed, except when part of an approved school activity.
- Chains or other heavy apparel may not be worn.
- "Trench" style coats may not be worn.

Pants must be worn around the waste and properly fitted. Underwear must be covered. Excessively baggy pants as well as excessively tight pants are unacceptable. Rips/tear in pants, shorts, and leggings must be below fingertip level with arms in relaxed position.

School safety is an important concern; therefore, also prohibited are clothing, jewelry, accessories, notebooks or any other item which, because of the way it is worn, its trade mark, or any other characteristic (such as color), carries known gang connotations. All items may be confiscated.

### Consequences for violating the Student Dress Code:

1<sup>st</sup> time 2 days lunch detention

2<sup>nd</sup> time 2 days after school work detail

3<sup>rd</sup> time 2 days of suspension

# DRESS CODE

**Purpose of the dress code:** is to promote a learning environment that is respectful and, free from distractions. Clothing must be **MODEST** and must not promote or glorify illegal, promiscuous, gang-related or racially-biased slogans or behaviors. In an effort to maintain a tasteful, academic atmosphere, bare feet, bare midriiffs, bare backs, bare shoulders, exposed underwear, pajamas, shirts or hats (caps) with literal figurative references to, or depictions of gangs, tobacco, drugs, alcohol, violence or discrimination will not be acceptable on campus.

Beach and casual attire, such as tube tops, fishnet shirts, tops with narrow straps, backless tops, halter- tops, excessively short shorts/skirts, and sunglasses, are also prohibited within the school setting. Shoulders must be covered. The hem of the shorts/skirt must reach the end of your fingertips when arms are down to your sides when standing.

Hats, caps, hoods, bandannas, scarves, and other head coverings may not be worn inside the school building.

School safety is an important concern; therefore, also prohibited are clothing, jewelry, accessories, notebooks or any item which, because of the way it is worn, the trade mark, or any other characteristic (such as color), carries known gang connotations. **All items may be confiscated.**
